For over a quarter of a century Carnegie Hall has been bringing fine live performances, varied art exhibits, and award-winning arts in education programs to southern West Virginia.

Through the efforts of a dedicated staff and an outstanding team of volunteers Carnegie Hall touches more than 75,000 patrons each year.

During the Spring of 2007, a group of interested people met to discuss the future needs of the Hall as it ***began its second century***. They agreed to call themselves The Carnegie Hall Guild.

The Board of Directors voted in May of 2007 to officially sponsor The Carnegie Hall Guild.
